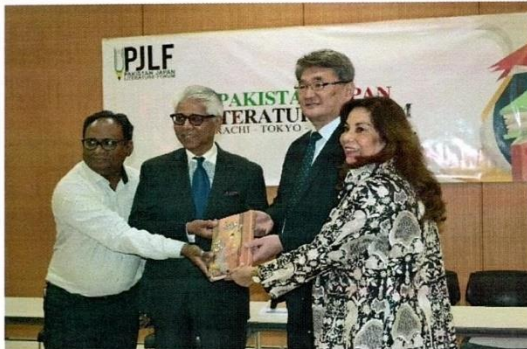

Conferral of Decoration to Ms. Sadia Rashid



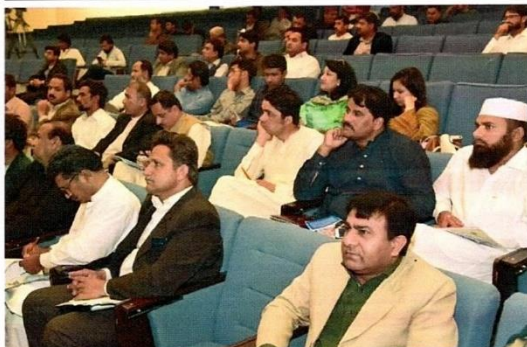

Japanese Calendar Exhibition 2019

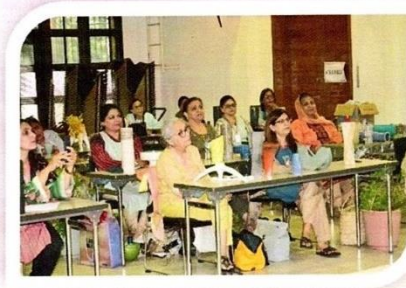
Opening Ceremony Feat. Wadaiko
