The End of WWII, and the Dawn of the Japan-Pakistan Friendship

San Francisco Peace Treaty (1951)

> 49 countries including Pakistan welcomed Japan's return to the International community

> Japan-Pakistan Diplomatic Relations (1952)

 \rightarrow 70th Anniversary of Commemoration (2022)

Karachi to be a World Business Center for Japanese businesses

Cotton trade between Pakistan and Japan flourished since 1950s

- > Pakistani cotton supported the very early stage of Japan's economic redevelopment
- > Karachi became the five largest business centers abroad for Japanese businesses (Karachi, New York, London, Hong Kong, Singapore)




Japan has always been supporting Pakistan's growth since 1950s: (power plants, roads, canals, tunnels, water facilities, hospitals, schools)



> Total amount of Japan's support: 12 Billion US dollars



Increasing Export to Japan

> Agricultural products (Ex. mango), Fishery products, Entertainment, E-sport, Textile, Sports gear

2 Investment in Pakistan by Japanese Companies

> Building Industries to Substitute the Import (Ex. dairy products, everyday-use products, pharmaceutical products)

- > Strengthening the Exporting Industries
- Ex. Car, Textile, Agriculture, Fishery, Food Processing (Morinaga Milk just opened a factory), Mining (precious stones)
- > Tourism (air-carries, transportation, hotels, restaurants, museums-upgrade)
